- Three winners will be selected from each grade category
- Festival Exhibition: As many posters as space allows will be on public display in the Central Branch of the Jefferson-Madison Regional Library. Following the Festival, posters can be picked up after April 1 at the Virginia Foundation, 145 Ednam Dr, 924-3296

- One Entry per person
- Posters must be 8.5"x14" **OR** 11" by 17"
- Each entry must be original art work and can be done in any medium
- Subject of poster must be book, literacy, or reading related
- Poster must include the text "Virginia Festival of the Book"
- On back of each poster one must place the student's name; school; grade; school address & phone number. Posters with names on front will be eliminated automatically
